Code of conduct for students

- 1. A student teachers are expected to be neat simple and mode in the appearance, to be punctual and regular in attendance to be wn and diligent in studies and discharge of duties and assignments
- 2. A student teachers must uphold noble values.respect elders and keep decency and decorum
- 3. The teacher trainees are expected to wear appropriate dress Specialdress is insisted on certain occasions.
- 4. A student teacher is expected to keep the college campus and class rooms clean
- 5. Time is precious Students who have free time, should not loiter along the verandah or premises, but either be in the reading room or in their own class rooms, fruitfully making use of the time.
- 6. Students are forbidden to attend or organize any meeting or collect money for any purpose, without the personal approval of the principal, They shall circulate any notice or petition among the students and exhibit them on the premises without having the signature of the principal
- 7. Audiovisual equipment shall be made used for academic purposes in class room with the consent of the class teacher if they are used for purposes other than academic prior sanction of the principal.
- 8. Students are not allowed to make complaints in a body or to address any authority

by a collective petition without the prior sanction of the principal

- 9. Misconduct of a serious nature or neglect of work by a student makes one liable to be declared unfit by the principal to become a teacher and the person will have to discontinue his/her studies in college.
- 10. On campus, students are expected to greet teachers and friends respectfully
- 11. Students should not make any marks on the furniture or wail any part of the college premises.
- 13. Use of mobile phones is not permitted during the class time in the campus

Code of conduct for teachers

For teachers to sustain a supportive and courteous learning environment for students, a code of conduct must be established. Here is a rough framework that you may use as a starting point for creating a code of conduct for teachers even if precise aspects may change based on the educational institution or organisation:

- 1. Engage in all interactions with students, coworkers, and parents with the utmost professionalism and ethics.
- 2. Uphold the educational institution's ideals and mission.
- 3. Respect, dignity, and justice should be shown to all students, regardless of their upbringing, skills, or behaviour.
- Avoid using insulting words, disparaging statements, or acting in a discriminatory manner.
- 5. To maintain a safe and secure learning environment, set appropriate boundaries between teachers and pupils.
- 6. Avoid participating in any improper behaviour.
- 7. Give all students safety and well being—both physically and emotionally—top priority.
- 8. Any worries concerning a student's welfare should be brought up with the proper authorities.
- 9. Give all students an equal chance to participate and succeed in both their academic

and social endeavours.

- Keep lines of communication open and transparent with parents, coworkers, and students.
- 11. Actively hear the wants and concerns of the pupils.
- 12. Make a commitment to ongoing professional development to improve your teaching abilities and stay current with the finest teaching techniques.
- 13. Use fair and dependable classroom management strategies to promote a supportive learning environment.
- 14. Encourage an environment that welcomes all students' active engagement, uphold academic honesty and encourage moral conduct among students.
- 15. Demonstrate a high level of professionalism and ethical behavior in all interactions with students, colleagues, and parents.
- 16. Treat all students with respect, dignity, and fairness, regardless of their background, abilities, or behavior.
- 17. Refrain from using offensive language, derogatory remarks, or discriminatory behavior.

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
